Beith-Birch



Pronounced 'beh'.
A fresh start, a new beginning, the old phase concluded. Change, cleansing, purification, cyclical law. Childbirth



Luis-Rowan



Pronounced 'lweesh'.
Protection against enchantment & other dangers. Defense, sanctuary, precautions. Control of the senses.



Fearn-Alder



Pronounced 'Fair-n.'
Prophecy, inspiration. The protection which comes from following good counsel & advice.



Saille-Willow



Pronounced 'Sahl-yuh.'
Feeling, intuition, psychic ability, lunar rhythms, spiritual advice, the feminine principle. Flexibility. 'Go with the flow.'



Nuin-Ash



Pronounced 'nee-un.'
Change, growth, transformation, fate, destiny. Option, possibilities, potential, evolution, crisis, larger reality.



Huath-Hawthorn



Pronounced 'hoo-ah.'
Obstacles, obstruction, complications, entanglement, a thorny situation. Only pain or shame if you press onward. No good options at the moment.



Duir-Oak



Pronounced 'doo-r.'
Strength, endurance, strong foundation. An established way of life, & a strong vocation. You are protected & supported in your pursuits.



Tinne-Holly



Pronounced 'chin-yuh.'
Challenge, testing, trials. Your position is under attack. Prepare to defend yourself. Tempering, strengthening.



Coll-Hazel

Pronounced 'cull.'

Wisdom, knowledge, enlightenment, inspiration. Knowledge straight from the source. Poetic & divinatory gifts.



Quert-Apple

Pronounced 'kwairt.'

A choice between equally attractive alternatives. Can also mean health, vitality, recovery, recuperation, wholeness, a respite.



Muin-Vine

Pronounced 'muhn.'

Work or a project completed, now comes harvest & celebration. The loosening of inhibitions & the truth which comes out as a result. Prophecy.



Gort-Ivy

Tenacity, survival, ruthlessness. Growth, either inner or outer. Ill treatment, restriction, exploitation. Breaking barriers, re-forming reality, achievement. Seeing clearly.



NgEtal-Reed

Pronounced 'nyeh-tl.'

Straif-Blackthorn

Pronounced 'strahf.'

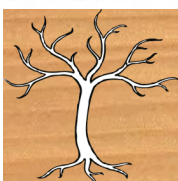
Strife, adversity, damage, either physical or emotional. A thorny experience. The compulsion of fate. No choice, however unpleasant.

Pronounced 'ahlm.'

Heightened consciousness, greater perspective. Elation, enthusiasm, wonder, awe. Peak experiences. Pain, poignancy, fear.



Ohn-Gorse

Pronounced 'uhn.'

Things are coming together for your benefit. A binding force. Attraction, sexuality, passion, sensuality, health & vitality. Gathering of sweetness & value.






Ur-Heather

Pronounced 'oor.'



A mature relationship & its consummation. Accepting the shadow side. Homemaking. Contact with the spirit world & the healing it can bring.

Eadha-Aspen

Pronounced 'eh-yuh.'



Fears, doubts, very long odds, & beating them. Testing, rite of passage. Mustering one's confidence; courage & warrior spirit; resolution.

Ioho-Yew

Pronounced 'ee-yoh.'



Death, endings, exits, transition, change. Something fading or withering, followed by renewal & re-birth. A new element is approaching.

Koad-Grove

Pronounced 'co-ahd.'
